OSCR launches new checking facility for charity trustees

Two new changes to charity law contained in the Charities (Regulation and Administration) (Scotland) Act 2023 came into effect on 1 October 2024. These changes relate to a <u>charity's</u> <u>connection to Scotland and a public Record of</u> <u>Removed Persons</u>.

OSCR's website now has a publicly searchable record of people removed from being concerned in the management and control of a charity. The individuals in this record have been disqualified from serving as charity trustees in Scotland by the Court of Session unless they have a waiver of disqualification. They must not be appointed as, or serve as, charity trustees. Additionally, charities on the Scottish Charity Register must now be able to demonstrate a connection to Scotland when conducting their activities.




There's still time to give us your views on important changes to charity law

Next year, there will be changes to the rules that automatically disqualify someone from undertaking certain functions within a charity.

The Charities Act 2023 will extended the range of offences that disqualify someone, and the rules will also apply to staff or volunteers with a senior management function, not just trustees.

Your views will help to inform our decision-making process, and will ensure that the changes to charity law are implemented in the most effective way.
